

50km Route Description

The JUST BIKE 50km route provides a great variety of terrains and scenery and is the perfect way to experience the broad and sweeping landscapes of the Ridgeway and Wessex.

For the first 9km the route starts by following quiet country lanes south from Coate Water Country Park, going through the village of Badbury, then and going over the M4 before climbing up onto the Ridgeway heading east. This part of the route follows the ancient track it is rough in places and gently undulates; expect some muddy and rutted patches!

The route continues along the Ridgeway for about 5km's then the route drops south on lanes and tracks down to the first power station at the village of Baydon after 22kms of cycling. From the first power station the route continues on road towards Aldbourne where the route goes back onto bumpy tracks and lanes down towards the village of Ramsbury. We use a hall here for the second power station. The route then takes on some more rough tracks passing over the hills to Ogbourne St George. From here the route joins the old railway line cycle route for an easy few miles heading north towards Swindon and the finish at Coate Water Country Park.
